Tutoring Policy

Tutors who are tutoring for pay may tutor their students at tables in the library. They may not book a study room in advance but if a study room is available when they come to the library they are welcome to use it.

Tutors who are not collecting pay may reserve the meeting rooms in advance, up to a maximum of five hours per week. If a study room is available when they come to the library, they are welcome to use it.

The library administration reserves the right to restrict tutoring activity during high-use periods.

Tutoring sessions held at tables in the public areas of the library may not disturb or impede the use of the library by other patrons.

Failure on the part of the tutor or student to comply with the Library's Behavior and Environment Policies shall result in the denial of the individual's privilege to tutor at the library.
