The traditional kitchen garden, also known as a potager (French) or a kailyaird (Scottish), is a source of herbs, vegetables and fruits typically placed near the house for easy access to the harvest. **Lawrence Davis-Hollander**, an ethnobotanist, garden writer and gardener will explore this kind of garden.
